### **C. V. Raman – The Man Who Made Light Speak**

Chandrasekhara Venkata Raman, commonly known as **C. V. Raman**, was an Indian physicist who made groundbreaking discoveries in the field of light scattering. Born on **November 7, 1888**, in Tamil Nadu, India, he showed exceptional brilliance in academics from an early age.

In **1928**, while working at the Indian Association for the Cultivation of Science, he discovered what is now known as the **Raman Effect**—the phenomenon where light changes its wavelength when passing through a transparent material. This discovery revolutionized the study of optics and earned him the **Nobel Prize in Physics in 1930**, making him the first Indian to receive a Nobel in science.

Raman's discovery had profound implications in fields like spectroscopy, chemistry, and quantum mechanics. His work laid the foundation for modern advancements in material science, forensic studies, and even space research.

## Amartya Sen – The Economist Who Redefined Development

**Amartya Sen**, born on **November 3, 1933**, in Santiniketan, India, is a renowned economist and philosopher known for his groundbreaking work on welfare economics, poverty, and human development.

Sen's research focused on economic and social justice, particularly how poverty and inequality impact people's well-being. His work on "**capability approach**" emphasized that development should not be measured merely by economic growth but by people's ability to access health, education, and opportunities.

One of his most significant contributions was his study on **famines**, where he proved that food shortages alone do not cause famines—rather, political and economic policies play a crucial role. His ideas influenced global policies on hunger, poverty alleviation, and social welfare.

In **1998**, he was awarded the **Nobel Prize in Economics** for his contributions to welfare economics. He has also been a key figure in shaping the **Human Development Index (HDI)** used by the United Nations.

Throughout his career, he has taught at prestigious institutions like **Harvard, Cambridge, and Oxford**, and his books, such as *Development as Freedom*, continue to shape economic thought world
